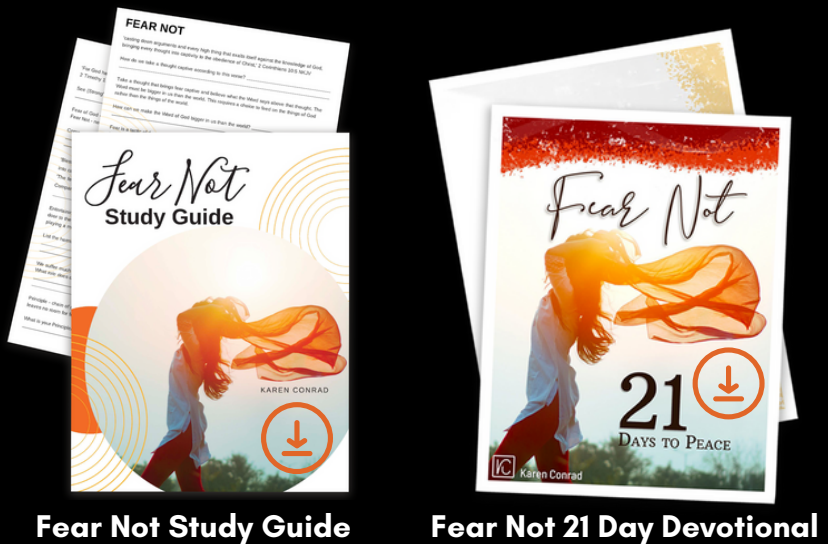

Fear Not 

*For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and love and of a sound mind. II Timothy 1:7 NKJV

Fear of God - positive, related to His good intentions toward us (Ezra 1:137) PPs 137:14
Fear Not - negative, from the enemy brings anxiety, worry, depression, suffering, Proverbs 29:25
 Encouraging/empowering fear causes our thoughts to be unclear, skewed and anxious, it opens the door for the enemy with unhealthy patterns of thinking, behaviors and emotions. Fear can be like playing a movie that is never happening. Imagination turns dangerous.

Take a thought that brings fear, regret and believe what the Word says above that thought. II Corinthians 10:5 - The Word that he began to have the world. There are a few things to be done on the things of God rather than the things of the world.

Fear is a lack of the enemy to keep us from fulfilling God's purpose in our lives.
 Fear of man gets in the way of purpose, confidence in the Lord brings safety and provision. Proverbs 29:5, Isaiah 51:7


Fear is often associated with punishment - if I do something wrong, it will bring punishment (Jezebel, Martin Luther King, General Robert E. Lee). Things that have not happened and may never happen. Love expels thoughts of fear and terror. (John 4:18, Isaiah 41:10, Isaiah 54:4)

Principle - chain of reasoning (how you process thoughts) when in fear with the Word of God leaves no room for fear.

Logical approach (process) for thoughts: Fear is from the enemy and there is no truth in the enemy John 8:44. Therefore there is no truth in fear.
 Does this thought bring fear? It is not from the Lord. II Timothy 1:7, John 18:10. Exchange that thought for a promise in God's Word. II Corinthians 10:5.
 Agree with the Word and turn away from fear.
 What we agree with is what has power in our lives.

Reversing thoughts against the Word of God
 Family: Knowing the Word is a key ingredient of our experience Ephesians 5:33, Proverbs 22:6
 Personal life: Think on these things, grab the thoughts and judge it through the Word Philippians 4:8
 Professional: Decisions and judgments based on fear bring loss Proverbs 19:13
 Financial: Cannot serve two masters Matthew 6:24
 Spiritual: Christ like abiding, He has promised it to you, Deuteronomy 30:19

I John 4:18 (Full Chapter)
 There is no fear in love [dread does not exist], but full-grown (complete, perfect) love turns fear out of doors and expels every trace of terror! For fear brings with it the thought of punishment, and [so] he who is afraid has not reached the full maturity of love [is not yet grown into love's complete perfection].

Genesis 15:1
 After these things, the word of the Lord came to Abram in a vision, saying, Fear not, Abram, I am your Shield, your abundant compensation, and your reward shall be exceedingly great.

Deuteronomy 1:21
